Dissemination of Microprocessor Courses through Classroom and Interactive Cyber-Enabled Technologies Workshop

Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Attendance is limited to 20 faculty members in each region and <u>each attendee will</u> receive a free PIC training system/kit, curriculum materials, a webcam, a microphone headset (a value of \$250+), plus \$400 for participation in the 3 days of professional development of teaching and learning.
- 2. The PIC training system/kit package and software will be mailed a week prior to the distance training workshop starting date. The attendees agree to test the required functions as stated in the package before joining the online workshop sessions.
- 3. Attendees must have access to high speed internet (DSL or cable) connections. Satellite and dial-up internet connects are not acceptable.
- 4. For those who attended the ATMAE or ITEEA conference workshop prior to this distance learning training and received the hardware and software will not get them via US postal services again.
- 5. **Reimbursement**: Each attendee will be eligible to receive \$400 for the professional development time after successfully competing <u>three</u> days of the on-line workshop. You will be asked to fill out a form where you will be asked to provide your social security number. The check will be mailed to you after the workshop.
- 6. There is an additional **\$100** available to those who complete a required project using the learned material and has the project verified by the member of the regional faculty.
- 7. Qualified workshop attendees include high school teachers who actively involved in STEM programs and 2 or 4 year higher education faculty.
- 8. Return of the PIC Training System (kit + webcam + microphone headset+ curriculum materials): If you register and are selected for this on-line training workshop and received the hardware and software, but yet fail to attend or miss any session of the workshop, you are then required to return all the materials which were provided to you.
- 9. It is expected that everyone is going to conduct several assessment surveys and tests before and after the workshop. Your identity will not be revealed, all the data from the project will only be used for workshop assessment and publication purposes.
- 10. This is a NSF funded grant that requires equal access to professional development activities and resources, especially underrepresented populations. The request of attendees' race/ethnicity information is solely to meet the requirements of the grant proposal obligation.
